

LEAD REIN class regulations

1. The class is performed in open category (without limits for age and growth for the horse and rider)
2. The class is dedicated for riders sitting on horses, which are leaded from the ground by another person.
3. The belaying person can walk next to the horse. This person cannot help in performing the obstacles in any way (opposite to the person who lead the horse – look at the point 14 of the regulation).
4. Parents or other guardians who applicate for participation of the horse and rider (and for the belaying person) thereby give their consent for start. Together with the application the accident insurance is required.
5. The way of leading the horse – look at the app. Nr 1 to the WEP Regulations
6. Min. age of the horse – 4 years
7. The gait for performers – walk only
8. Only test of maneability is gamed
9. Min. No of obstacles – 4, max 8
10. Min. Age of the person who leads the horse – 15 years
11. Min. Age of the rider – 2 years finished at the time of the competition is gamed
12. Each rider must be equipped in:
 - a. Properly fitted 3 point fastening protective helmet.
 - b. Properly fitted safety vest or other vertebrate and back protection.
 - c. The only exception from above are children in age under 5 years who start with the belaying person.
13. The judge taking into account the competitor's safety has the right to interrupt the run in any situation which affects in his opinion the security risk. The run than may be continued with the consent of judge if the rider and horse are safe.
14. Jeźdźcy pokonują test zręczności zgodnie ze swoimi możliwościami oraz z pomocą osoby prowadzącej konia (np. pomoc przy sięgnięciu po/ w odłożeniu kubeczka, dzwonienie dzwonkiem, domknięcie bramki, sięgnięcie po dzbanek).
15. Riders perform the maneability test according to their abilities and with help of the horse' leader (ex. reaching/putting back the jag, ringing the bell ect.)
16. After the end of the competition there is no final classification. Each competitor, who participates in competition receives a diploma and prize ribbon. Other additional prizes are given to competitors according to organizer decision and possibilities.
17. This class – regardless of the type of competition - can be judge by any adult member of the WEP association, WEP judge or international WAVE judge.
